Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Carroll County Wastewater Upgrades and Lift Station Replacements Project in Fiscal Year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is Carroll County, Ohio, located at 119 South Lisbon St., Suite 201, Carrollton, Ohio, 44615.

The funding would be used to replace six sewer lift stations and provide electrical repairs and updates to another five lift stations. These lift stations are failing, risking the water quality of nearby Lake Mohawk and sewer services for residents of northwest Carroll County.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will ensure Carroll County Environmental Services can continue to provide wastewater services to residents, meet state and local EPA requirements, and have the wastewater infrastructure necessary to support growth in the region.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under 42 U.S. Code section 5305(a)(2).
